Reception Graduation Assembly—well done everyone you made us very proud. What an amazing year it's been and you have achieved so much.

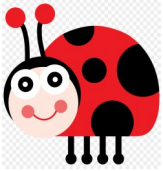


Butterflies enjoyed ending the week with **Scot Fit**—the children learnt how to safely ride their scoters and challenge themselves.

Year 2 Caterpillars Update

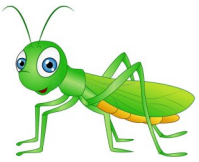

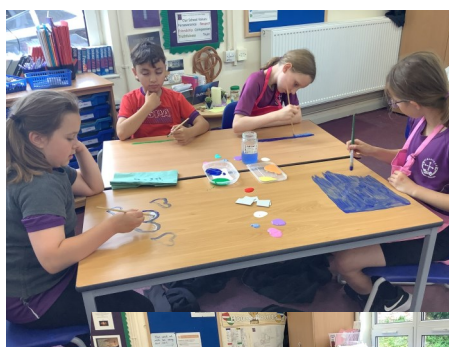
