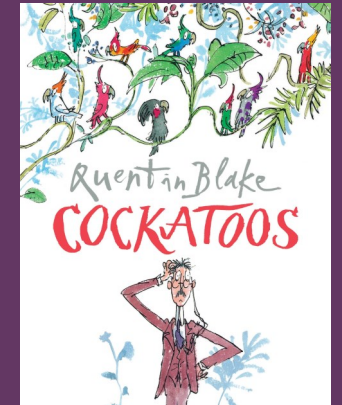

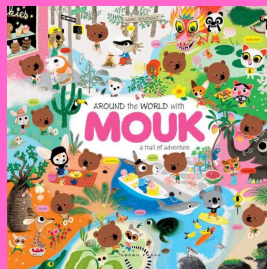

Reading and copy writing tricky words. Writing names, developing letter formation, writing lists, labels, phrases and simple sentences.

Fine Motor, Gross Motor & PE
