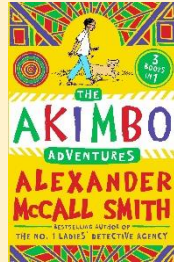
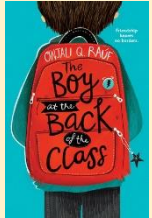

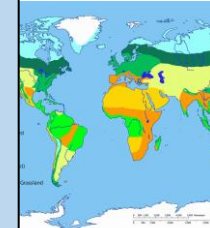
- Exploring different biomes. What is a biome? Where are the different biomes around the world?
