How are nutrients transported around the body?

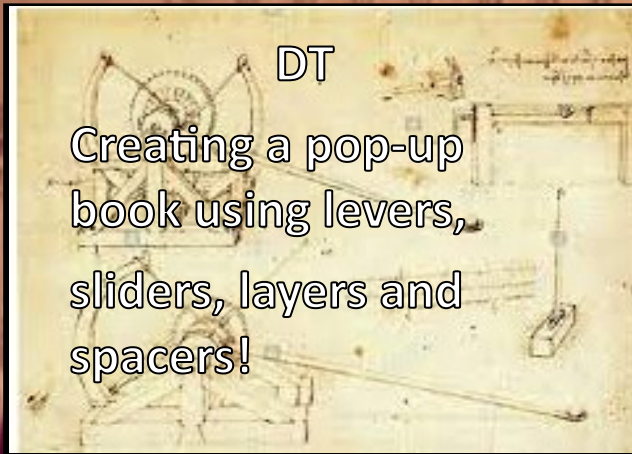
What are the effects of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the human body?
