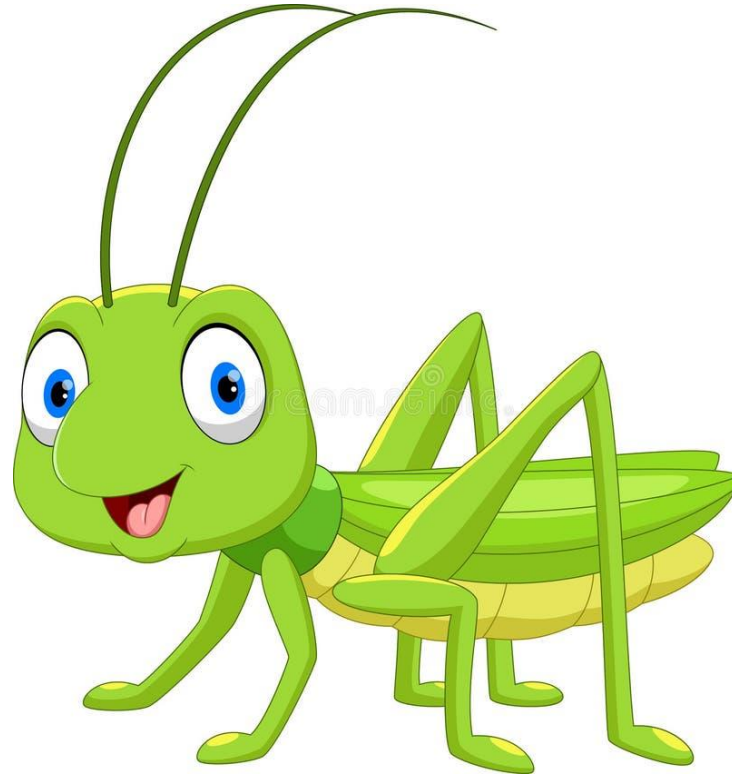


Welcome to Year 3

Home Learning in Year 3

- **Reading:** children should be reading for 20 minutes, with or without an adult, per day. *This does not need to be their 'school' book. Children can bring books from home, record in reading record.*
- **Spelling:** Children will be given 10 spellings each week to practise at home for a test the following Friday. Some Year 1 & 2 key word recap.
- **Times table practise:** The children will be securing their **2, 5 & 10** times tables then learning their **3, 4 & 8s**. We will probably also look at **11s and 9s**. They should be practising them each week. If they don't currently know 2, 5 & 10 then please spend some time learning them over the holidays.
- **HWK:** the children will be asked to choose a maths, an English and 2 foundation based tasks for a half term (Autumn). In Spring & Summer, the children will have the whole term so will be asked to complete both maths and English tasks and 2 foundations tasks. *Please let me know if HWK is an issue and we can work out the best way for your child to complete it without added stress.*
