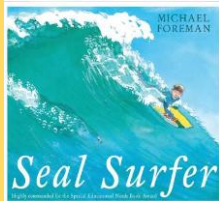
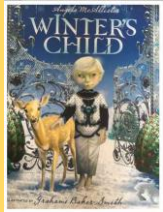

HISTORY

SCIENCE – Forces & Magnets / Animals including humans

Forces & Magnets: Learn that forces can make objects move, stop,
speed up, slow down or change direction. They explore contact forces
such as friction and non-contact forces, including magnetism,
investigating magnetic materials and how magnets attract or repel.

Animals Including Humans: Children learn about the importance
of a balanced diet, the different functions of the human skeleton
and muscles, and how muscles work in pairs to help the body
move.
